

Dear Sir / Madam, applicant for PCR Test!

PCR can be used for virus identification, after the day of infection

- after the initial days of the incubation period (1-14 days, in average 5 days)
 - during the symptomatic period – to the best of our knowledge today –
 - after the termination of the disease, that is, up to two weeks after becoming symptom
- Kelen Hospital assistant trained for this examination will take sample of the pharynx and nasal mucosa. Sampling should be done vigorously in order to include the cells from the mucosa.
 - The sample will be forwarded to an accredited microbiology laboratory affiliated with Kelen Hospital, without your personal information, using a unique identifier that we have generated, where the sample will be tested by PCR to identify the SARS CoV-2 virus-specific nucleic acid segments.
 - The results will be evaluated by a qualified biologist and reported to Kelen Hospital. Kelen Hospital will notify you electronically of the results within two days.

What could be the result of the PCR test?

positive: the virus is detectable, you are contagious. If you are in good condition, inform your GP by phone and be at home in quarantine. Kelen Hospital notifies the Public Health Department of the Government in accordance with the epidemiological procedure, which orders quarantine. If you are not feeling well, you can notify your GP by phone, who will take care of a transport to a hospital. If you have any further question, call our reception on 0612050205.

negative: the virus is not detectable. The decision must be made about the next steps, in the knowledge of your medical history

What adverse reactions are to be expected?

- a. Sampling is uncomfortable, can cause vomituration, and is very rarely could be painful
- b. The sampling site may bleed temporarily. This is mainly happening if you are taking an anticoagulant, an inhibitor of platelet aggregation.
- c. If you make a sudden large movement during the test, the sampler may break and this should rarely be removed with forceps.

I hereby confirm having read, understood and accepted the Privacy Notice handed to me on a separate sheet.

I have read and understood this information sheet, was granted an opportunity to ask questions and received comprehensible, in-depth answers to them.
