You have been applied for SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus microbiological antibody test.

- on the one hand by enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (ELISA)
- and chemiluminescent microparticle immunoassay (CMIA), an improved version of the ELISA method. (This type of assay is in the Hungarian press as "Abbott IgG".)

A. What test do you apply for?

ELISA: IgA/IgM IgG CMIA: IgG

1. Our coordinator will accompany you to the examination room, where you can get seated after washing your hands.
2. After alcohol disinfection, blood is taken from your arm vein. The puncture site is covered with a bandage and you can leave the examination room.
3. The results of the test will be sent to the e-mail address you provided within 48-72 hours.

B. How accurate are the test results?

The 99.2-99,7% sensitivity and specificity data provided by the manufacturer were also confirmed by comparative studies. The reliability of the SARS-CoV-2 serological results to be published is also greatly enhanced by the fact that all findings are validated and interpreted by microbiologists experienced in the serology of infection

C. What adverse reactions are to be expected?

1. The site of the blood taking may be temporarily painful.
2. Very rarely, inflammation may develop at the puncture site. This is possible despite hand washing and disinfection, as the skin can never be made completely bacteria-free, and during the sting the pathogen can get into the deeper layers just like when you accidentally stab your finger with a needle in your home. The frequency of this is so rare that it is not even mentioned in the World Health Organization protocol
